**Minutes**

**Call to Order:**

It was explained that this site walk was relative to the Alteration of Terrain permit application submitted to NH Department of Environmental Services. As this work falls within the Designated Corridor of the Pemigewasset River, PRLAC has opportunity to submit comments to NH DES on this application.

Alan Barnard gave a short history of the site. Topics discussed included flood calculations, predicted runoff from the site, and the detention pond. Also discussed were salt & sand policies, contaminants, and filtration. The group was told that the 250' corridor setback line will be shown on the plans. On the walk, buffer areas were pointed out and river levels, erosion, seasonally wet areas, and site access were discussed.

M. O'Donnell will put together draft comments to be reviewed and approved at the June 30, 2015 PRLAC meeting.
