

## Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Disposal Options

### *Annual Lakes Region HHW Collections Event*

- **Lakes Region Household Hazardous Product Facility (Wolfeboro, NH)** accepts hazardous waste from residents and businesses in New Hampshire every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday, May through October from 8:30am – noon at the Wolfeboro facility and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday in July and September from 8:30am – noon at the Alton transfer station.
  - Household disposal fee is \$50 for every 5 gallons of waste
  - Small businesses need to call ahead; households do not need an appointment

- **Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission (UVLSRPC)** allows non-district residents and small businesses to dispose of their waste for a fee. There are 5 scheduled collections that run from 9am – noon.
  - Non-residents must pay a fee of \$30 to dispose of up to 25 pounds (or 5 gallons).
  - Small businesses MUST call and pre-register 2 weeks in advance to receive a price quote.
