Children's/YA Librarian Report:

July contained the bulk of our summer reading programming; in addition to continuing yoga twice a week and storytimes twice a week, we also hosted a D&D Lite series (the last occurrence is on August 4), had a Zoom visit with Karen Land and her sled dog Noggin, hosted a PLIX Space Food workshop, and on the eve of the Mars 2020 Perseverance Rover launch, we Zoomed with a JPL Solar System Ambassador and a former astronaut (current MIT professor, who has an experiment on the rover). The end of the month saw the beginning of a four-week series, Bounce Back Summer Camp, designed to help kids 8-12 cope with the uncertainties of life during a pandemic.

Our Massachusetts Board of Library Commissioners CARES grant for Virtual Programming for Distance Learning in the amount of \$3,038.00 was approved by the Board of Selectmen on August 3, 2020.
