1. THE HAYDENVILLE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION WAS ORGANIZED IN 1850 WHEN IT WAS VOTED THAT THE DIRECTORS PERMIT THE TOWN OF HAYDENVILLE TO TAKE TO THE ASSOCIATION THE LAND IN HAYDENVILLE OCCUPIED AS A BURYING PLACE. SEE "HAYDENVILLE RECORDS" BY DR. CHARLES A. WHEELER, AT FORBES LIBRARY.
