General Discussion:

- Hooksett's first pod of self pickup lockers have arrived and they are "test driving" them
 with staff and trustees. They also have engaged in a digitization project to coincide with
 their Town's bicentennial celebration with support from Bobbi at the State Library.
- Hampstead Library has purchased Tonieboxes and launchpads with ARPA funds.
- <u>Uline</u> is a potential vendor for packaging materials possibly for <u>Wonderbooks</u> that Concord Public Library is purchasing soon.
- Hooksett is using Amazon Kindles in Children's Department with subscription.
- Dover has purchased a 3D Doodler Pen for patrons to try out.
- Hampstead library has a **Sculpt 2 3D Printer** from Jo Ann's Fabric / Creative Bug that they received for free. It has been helpful for printing summer reading display items via Thingiverse.
- The State Library doesn't have an update on <u>NED robotic arms</u> yet, but hopefully coming in the fall. Plan is for one device per coop. Also working on some **VR training** for September.
- Bobbi mentioned Goodreads app that allows scanning of the cover to get book details, and more.
- Hampstead Library **displays a tablet** at the front desk to promote eBooks and spark conversations about the library's services & apps. They also use their tablets to demo ebook/eaudiobook services to patrons.
- For children's audiobooks, and audiobooks in general, **Tumblebooks and Hoopla** were both discussed. There was also some discussion about the limitations of **Playaways** for older audiences (small buttons, difficult to navigate, etc.)
