

### **Finance Committee Annual Report 2022-23**

The Finance Committee oversees the management of NHLTA's finances, and it also serves as the Scholarship Committee for the Mildred P. McKay Library Scholarship Fund. The committee establishes and periodically reviews financial policies, procedures and practices to ensure proper financial management.

William J. Shea, CPA, PLLC of Nashua, NH, independently conducted NHLTA's annual financial review for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022. Shea also prepared NHLTA's IRS and NH returns. The Board of Directors reviewed Shea's report at its January 4, 2023 meeting. NHLTA's financial statements are reviewed annually by an independent Certified Public Accountant.

In calendar year 2022, the Scholarship Committee awarded sixteen full or partial McKay scholarships, including five MLS / MLIS course scholarships. For 2023, as of May 31, ten scholarships have been awarded, including one MLS / MLIS course scholarship.

Mildred P. McKay was New Hampshire State Librarian, 1942 – 1964. In 1965, NHLTA established the Mildred P. McKay Library Scholarship Fund. The New Hampshire Charitable Foundation annually grants NHLTA new funds for McKay scholarship awards.
