In 1975, Sue Palmatier began 33 years of work for the NH State Library as a public library consultant working in Library Development first in the Keene and Concord offices, then in the North Country Office. She served as Supervisor of Library Development and was a partner in Upcountry Consultants, a library planning business. An expert in library space planning and strategic planning for libraries, Sue taught classes in all aspects of librarianship, training many North Country librarians.
