

Determining eligibility for issuing a New Hampton Transfer Station sticker

IN ALL CASES THE REGISTRATION MUST BE PRESENTED FOR THE VEHICLE(S) BEING USED TO ACCESS THE TRANSFER STATION

REGISTRATION STATUS

TYPE

Standard Annual Sticker

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| A Registration matches name and address in New Hampton | Issue the standard sticker |
| B Registration does not match an address in New Hampton | Use BMSI records to confirm whether name listed on registration matches a property owner in New Hampton who has land AND BUILDING. <u>A land only property does not generate trash, therefore, a transfer station sticker would not be needed.</u> If the requester is a renter - documentation is required to associate them with a physical address in New Hampton. |
| C Registration is in a company name | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1 If the company name is for a leased vehicle which also contains the property owner's name as "Leasee" and they meet the criteria in A and B2 If the company is located in the town of New Hampton |

Selectmen's Office issued letter w/sticker

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| D Registration is for friend/relative who needs to assist a New Hampton property owner with their waste | <ol style="list-style-type: none">3 If the registration is not for a leased vehicle then the Selectmen's Office will issue a letter, once land and/or building ownership in New Hampton is confirmed. This letter will specifically state that the permit is for hauling residential waste from a specific location in New Hampton, and expires on Dec. 31st of the year of issue. Selectmen's Office will issue either a letter (as in C2) or a temporary transfer station pass, depending on each situation. In most cases it requires a confirmation from the property owner that this is necessary. |
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Selectmen's Office issued Temporary Transfer Station Permit

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| E Contractor/builder, etc. needs to remove construction debris from a New Hampton resident's property | Selectmen's Office will issue a temporary transfer station pass. This requires a confirmation from the property owner that this specific individual is performing work for them at their New Hampton property. |
| F Registration is for a rental vehicle | Same procedure as "D" |
| G Registration is for camper in Twin Tamarack or Ames Brook Campgrounds | Selectmen's Office <u>may</u> issue a temporary transfer station pass upon confirmation that camper owns a taxable trailer in the campground. |
| H Registration is for a property owner who owns LAND ONLY | For some situations a temporary pass <u>may</u> be available through the Selectmen's Office. |
