To: Residents of the Town of New Hampton

The Supervisors of the Checklist for the Town of New Hampton will be in Session on Tuesday, January 22, 2019 from 7:00 pm to 7:30 pm at the Town Offices, 6 Pinnacle Hill Road, New Hampton, New Hampshire.

The purpose of this Session is to accept new voter registration applications and to make corrections to the Checklist, including change of party or return to Undeclared.

Applicants for registration who possess proof of identity, age, citizenship, and domicile should bring that proof when they come to register. Qualified applicants who do not possess proof or who do not bring proof with them may register if they sign an affidavit attesting to their qualifications for identity, age, and citizenship.

Within 30 days of an election and on election day, applicants without proof of domicile with them may register to vote if they sign an affidavit attesting to their domicile and either agreeing to bring or send in proof or attesting that they are not aware of possessing proof of domicile.

New Hampton's Tax Rate 2017 vs. 2018

The NH Department of Revenue has just set New Hampton's Tax Rate at **\$17.87** per thousand dollars in assessed valuation.

Tax Rate Breakdown
