NOTICE TO TAX PAYERS

Tax Bills will be late this year!!!!

The Town of New Hampton is still waiting for its Tax Rate. There are 4 parts that make up a tax rate (Town, County, Local Education and State Education), and the DRA (Department of Revenue Administration), who sets our tax rate, is still missing reports from the Newfound Area School District (SAU 4). The Town has been prepared and waiting for the other parties since the end of October. We remain in contact with SAU 4 and are getting weekly updates on their progress. For those wishing to put any money toward their upcoming bill, we will be accepting payments. You will still receive a bill. It will show either a credit or that money is still due.

IMPORTANT message from Fire Chief Scott Cathy

2024 has been a tragic year for fire and carbon monoxide related deaths in New Hampshire. So far, in 2024 NH has experienced more deaths from fire and carbon monoxide than the two previous years combined!

The New Hampton Fire Department, in partnership with the NH Fire Marshal's Office, is offering free smoke/carbon monoxide detectors for those residents who need a detector for their home. Please call the firehouse, 603-744-2735, or stop in, to get your free detector.

Attention Boat Owners

NH Boat Agents CANNOT register Boats at this time.

The State of NH DMV is waiting to receive the new Federal Decals that MUST accompany the regular boat decal.

The State of NH DMV will mail out the renewal letters for 2025 Boats, once they receive the new Federal decals.

All Boat Agents in NH (including New Hampton's Town Clerk) will be able to process boat registrations once the decals are dispersed to the various locations.
