**Continued Work on Drake, Sinclair Hill, Pinnacle Hill,
Hillside & Ridge Roads**

Public Works Director Jim Boucher expresses appreciation for the ongoing patience and understanding shown by residents and motorists while the department makes improvements in and along these roads in preparation for reclamation and paving.

The department has replaced 27 culverts, has had to install approximately 500 feet of underdrain systems due to the amount of water coming off of Pinnacle Hill, and will soon be removing several large boulders. Additional roads closures will be necessary but signage will be in place, and the website updated, to advise motorists of the closures.

New Hampshire law requires that the Supervisors of the Checklist verify the Checklist every ten years. Any voter who has not voted in the last four years must re-register to remain on the Checklist. The Supervisors are sending Notice Letters to these voters at the address provided when the voter registered.

The Supervisors of the Checklist for the Town of New Hampton will hold a second and third public session for:

- Re-registering voters who have not voted since April 1, 2017;
- Accepting applications for new voter registration;
- Accepting requests for correction of the Checklist;
- and changes in party affiliation on.

Those applying to register must bring: proof of citizenship (birth certificate or passport) and proof of domicile (e.g. utility bill).
