Surveys have been mailed to all property owners in town. Included with the survey are addressed envelopes so you can mail them back, or feel free to drop them off at the Town Office. For residents who are not property owners, or if more than person in your household would like to complete the survey additional surveys will be available at the Town Office, Transfer Station, and the Gordon-Nash Library later during the week of September 23rd. The Master Plan is the foundation for guiding the development in our community. Using this Master Plan as the foundation, the Planning Board enacts regulations on zoning, subdivision and site planning. It is used as a tool for future town planning that best fits the needs and wants of residents, property owners, and business owners, while addressing demands on Town services. The Master Plan shows where

improvements may be necessary and where future action may be required to meet the needs of the community.
