As stated on the website for the Northern Pass project, Forward NH Plan, the redesigned Northern minimizes impacts by using existing transmission corridors and public roadways. Northern Pass in August unveiled a modified route that includes an additional 52 miles of underground technology that eliminates the potential for visual impacts in and around the White Mountain National Forest. The proposed Northern Pass line crosses the Canadian border in Pittsburg and heads south, where it runs mainly **UNDERGROUND before reaching Bridgewater**, where the line returns to **OVERHEAD** as it continues through New Hampton and further south.
