Painted canvas floor coverings, known as "oil clothes" in England, were used to decorate many homes in New England in the 18th & 19th centuries. There is a renewed interest in these hand painted canvas rugs, best described as "art for your floor". Made of 100% cotton canvas, they are suitable for use anywhere in your home. Our presenter, Lisa Curry Mair, owner of "Canvasworks" in Vermont, is a master of this art and will share her designs, made as they would have been hundreds of years ago-one painstakingly slow step at a time. She uses little more than paints, brushes and a sewing machine to create each work of floor art. Since 1992, she has created over 800 floorcloths that can be found in private homes and historic museums and she has been featured in magazines including "Early American Life" and "Country Living".
