New Hampton Tax Rate for 2014

2014 Tax rate of \$17.62 down from 2013 rate of \$19.17

New Hampton's tax bills are being mailed the first of next week and will be due on Thursday, December 18th. Please note the Town Clerk/ Tax Collector's new hours:

A reduction of \$1.55/1000 on the tax rate, results in a home assessed at \$200,000, seeing a reduction of \$310.00 in real estate taxes for this year (note: unless improvements or other changes were made to the property). The Newfound School District portion went down significantly from \$8.70 to \$7.49/1000.

Smoke Alarm Safety

Smoke alarms should be installed on every level of the home as well as outside each sleeping area. These alarms should be tested monthly and replaced every 10 years. When you change your clock in the Fall and Spring, be sure to use this as an opportunity to change the batteries in the alarms as well. Remember testing your smoke alarms will keep your family safe. Also consider carbon monoxide detectors for your home.
