Seeking Proposals from Contractors for Snowplowing

Contractor Snowplowing

The Town of New Hampton Public Works Dept. is seeking proposals from contractors for the 2013-2014 season to perform snowplowing, sanding and salting of town roads, parking areas, etc. as designated by the Public Works Director. Must provide truck with snow plow, sander, and operator. The contractor must be available on call for snow and ice storms. The proposals must include a detailed description of the equipment offered and an hourly rate for the equipment and operator. Certificates of Insurance and Workers Comp (if necessary) are required to be submitted with the proposal.
