HURRICANE SANDY

It is expected that Hurricane Sandy will be a tropical depression by the time it reaches our area. We are still anticipating several inches of rain which may cause flooding, wind and wind gusts that may cause down trees and power lines. There could be some flooding. Please stay at home this evening if your travel is not essential. Our Police, Fire/EMS, Emergency Management and Public Works Departments are prepared to deal with the storm conditions and

impact on our roads. Emergency Medical Services is also on standby if needed.

The following is recommended:

- * Secure all loose objects in your yards.
- * Don't drive on flooded roadways.
- * Don't venture outside during the storm because of the danger of flying debris.
- * Stay away from downed utility wires and assume they are live.
- * Operate emergency generators only in well-ventilated areas to avoid the buildup of deadly carbon monoxide gas.

If you see any downed power lines please do not approach the area, call 9-1-1 and we will secure the area and contact the appropriate service company to repair the lines. If you need emergency assistance please call 9-1-1.

Straits Road Culvert Project Scheduled to begin on October 22, 2012 <u>has been postponed</u> until December 3rd.

Please be advised that as a result of Warrant Article #7 approval at the March of 2012 Town Meeting, an existing culvert on Straits Road will be replaced. This culvert has repeatedly failed in heavy rain and flooding events. To address the inadequacy of this culvert the Public Works Director researched the town records and found documentation of numerous events and repeated expense which supported an application for a grant. This is the 2nd of three (3) grants the town has received. The grant has been approved and 75% of this project will be funded by a State of NH Hazard Mitigation Grant. The location of this project is 2 miles east from the Dana Hill Road Intersection with Straits Road. It is between the resident's house number #386 and #470 Straits Road. It is an existing culvert crossing at the bottom of the hill.

This culvert replacement project is expected to commence on Monday, December 3, 2012. This project is estimated to be a 5-6 week construction project. During that time there will be approximately a 5-day period where there will be no thru traffic, which means a closure of Straits Road at the culvert location. All traffic must use alternative routes, traveling either east or west on Straits Road, to avoid the project area. Our Police and Fire/EMS Departments have been notified of the closure plan. These departments with the support of other local emergency service departments through Mutual Aid will be prepared to respond to any emergencies.

If you would like to view the plans they are available at the town office during office hours (M-F 8:30am to 4pm) or on the town website www.new-hampton.nh.us. We will post on the town web site and send an "Email Connection" advising of the actual dates of closure and when the road will reopen. You can also call the town office or Public Works Department for updates.
