The New Hampton Historical Society and the Town of New Hampton have been awarded a grant to restore two painted stage curtains found in the Grange Hall and the Town House. This program will be a kick-off for a Fall through Spring community project. The Director of Curtains Without Borders, Christine Hadsel, will be explaining the detailed processes involved in the restoration. A hundred years ago, grand drapes and painted backdrops were the primary artistic feature of the cultural life of almost every village and town in Northern New England and were found in town and grange halls, theaters and opera houses. Curtains Without Borders is a conservation project dedicated to documenting and preserving historic painted scenery.
