RSA 91-A:3, II(c) Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of this board, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to include any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.

RSA91-A:3, II(l) Consideration of legal advice provided by legal counsel, either in writing or orally, to one or members of the public body, even where legal counsel is not present.
