

Teens Take the Lead

Thank you for your interest in presenting a teen led program at the Northborough Free Library! We review applications quarterly from teens interested in leading a program. Applications will be evaluated within 2 weeks following the quarterly deadline listed below. The Teen Librarian may require additional information from an applicant before making a final decision on an application, and if interested, applicants will be given two weeks to provide it. Please be aware that the library is only able to approve a limited number of applications per quarter. The decision of the Teen Librarian regarding the approval or denial of an application is final.

Applications received by:

October 15th will be considered for Winter Programming (December, January, February) January 15th will be considered for Spring Programming (March, April, May) April 15th will be considered for Summer Programming (June, July, August) July 15th will be considered for Fall Programming (September, October, November)

Selection decisions will be made using the following criteria:

- Quality of the application
 - Applicant has completed all information requested in the application
 - Program is well thought out and detailed.
 - Applicant clearly articulates the reasons for selecting the chosen program.
 - Materials are presented in an organized manner.
 - o Potential costs are identified.
 - Possible pitfalls and challenges in successfully completing the program are considered.
- Responsiveness to the Teen Librarian during the application process.
- Appropriateness of the program for the audience identified, and the library in general.
- Other current or upcoming library program offerings.

Successful applicants will be provided with:

- Limited mentoring from the Teen Librarian to guide the development of the content, program structure, and advertising plan.
- Program space, including tables, chairs, whiteboards, markers, laptops, projectors/screens.
- Print and online advertising (posting to the library's website/event calendar will be done by the Teen Librarian).
- Copies of handouts for the program (where applicable).
