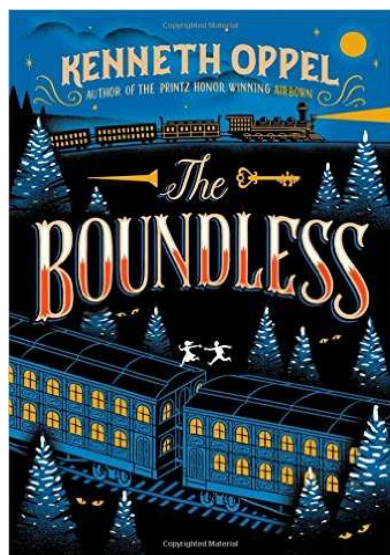
Fall Open House

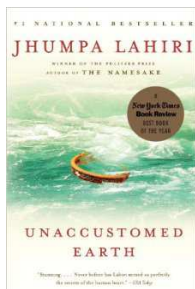
sale starts at 2PM). The sale is located in the Children's Craft Room at the Library.

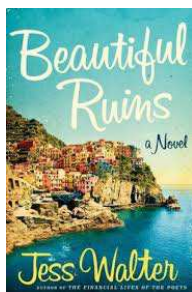
October 9 Unaccustomed Earth, by Jhumpa Lahiri

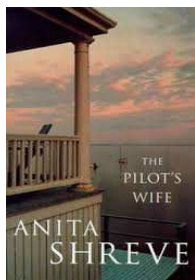
October 19 Beautiful Ruins, by Jess Walter

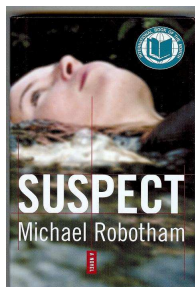
October 21 The Pilot's Wife, by Anita Shreve
