- Liberty Science Center passes: Program was a huge success, and all passes are sold out. Library will buy another set of 20 tickets using money from sale of previous tickets, and may need Friends to donate additional funds towards purchase.

New Business:

- St. Patrick's Day program 3/25 10am-noon: Flier and Sign up Genius (indicating that baked items must be individually wrapped and leftovers picked up at end) emailed. Most slots are filled for set-up, crafts/activities, food/drink donations, bake sale table and break-down. Miss Janet will do story time.

Will revisit discussion about pricing/registration/payment when a date is selected (\$200 program charge, suggested \$10 per person admission, possibly use EventKeeper for registration but would need to collect payment in advance).
