Financial Report (Eileen Manley) As of 8/31 we have \$18,214.59 in the bank with no outstanding bills.

### **Old Business:**

- **Jazz Up Comedy Fundraiser:** Coming up Sept. 30, 6:30pm. About 20 signed up so far. FR will post to Ringwood Moms and other FB groups.

We will need volunteers! FR will post on social media pages and ABG has already sent to Lakeland and other service clubs. YA will stay upstairs. We will sell the remaining apparel. Wendy S to talk to town for extra dumpster removal. We could use donations of collapsible banker's boxes.
- Cupsaw Lake Artisan Fair: Saturday, Nov. 11. We will have a table and will need volunteers to staff. We will look for a crate's worth of children/YA books to sell at the table. FR approached Rachel Marko about donating 1-2 of her prints. Discussion started about what kinds of arts/crafts we could reasonably sell at the table (included WL son donating cat toys, FR daughter donating homemade dog biscuits to be paired with books about animals; donations from the sketch group, etc) but was tabled for a future meeting. We want to consider new merchandise (apparel, possibly mugs).

## **New Business:**

- Adding a Friends Budget line in 2024 budget: FR and EM will look through notes from January to date to see what money we have spent so that WS can add a line item to the Library's budget
