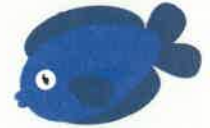

September 16-November 11, 2023, 1-4pm**

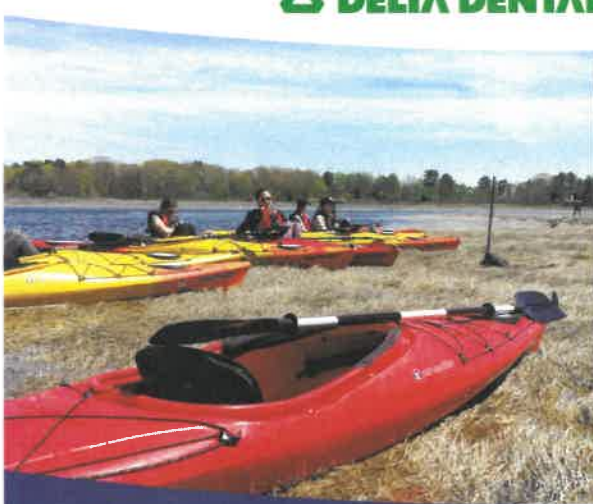
## Students will:
