



## South Haven Memorial Library September 13, 2022 Minutes

**Call to order:** The meeting was called to order by president, L Howard at 7:00 p.m.

**Approval of minutes for meeting on August 9, 2022:** Motion for approval by L. Smith, supported by E. Shumaker. Motion carried. A copy will be sent to city council.

**Approval of agenda for September 12, 2022:** Motion to approve: by J. Stein, supported by E. Shumaker, motion carried.

**Public Comments:** J. Canonie asked first about how the Library is funded: Federal or State? J. France explained that funding only comes from the state. Second, he asked when the patron computers will be ready for use. J. France described the challenges of setting up the computers on the new network that requires a technician. Further, he noted that the tech is supposed to be at the library by the end of the week and stated that he anticipates the patron computers to be live by the end of the month at the latest.

**Treasurer's report: Operations-Total income:** \$44,735.45, **Total expenses:** \$41,086.46, **Vendors' bills** totaled \$39,596.22 for the month. Motion to pay vendor bills by L Smith, supported by J. Stein. Motion carried.

**Renovation Budget Report:** Total Income: \$22,263.61 primarily from city taxes; Total Expenses: \$0

### **Director's Report:**

- Overdrive checkouts-780, MEL: Borrowed 211, Loaned 72; Patrons through the doors: 4,055. Small meeting room uses: 32.
- No painters contacted have responded to paint exterior wall facing Phoenix Street at this point.
- The Art Center will provide a plaque for donated sculpture: dedication in 3-5 weeks.
- MConsole scheduled in Thursday (9/15) for patron computers.
- Security cameras are in place: pictures currently in J. France office.
- Community Room is to be ready soon.
- Research is being done for an awning for the back entry and for microfilm equipment.
- Data and comments are being finished up for annual audit. Presentation will be in October or November depending on auditor's schedule.
