DID YOU KNOW...

Effective November 1, 2022, textiles are banned from disposal or transport for disposal in Massachusetts.

Textiles should never go in your household recycling bin. They also do not belong in the trash, unless they are wet, moldy, or contaminated. You can drop off textiles at designated collection bins or donate them to your favorite charity or thrift store.
