Getting Started

Looking to add some indie bling to your backpack? Need some promotional materials for your student club? Button making is a fast and fun way to customize your accessories and create memorable keepsakes!

Materials Needed

Artwork:

- Old comics, magazines, etc.
- Custom-designed illustrations

Button Components:

- You will need the top and bottom stainless pieces
- 1 piece of circular mylar

Cutting Your Artwork

There are two options to cut your artwork so that it fits the molded button pieces properly:

- 1. Use the provided cutter blade and glass
- 2. Trace a 3.5" circular template and cut with scissors (helpful tip: this method is a bit easier)
