- D. Names of colleges or schools to which student has applied and the acceptance status.
- E. Short paragraph on area of academic concentration and future goals.
- F. An essay (300-500 words) focusing on a person or event that influenced your career choice.
- G. Student's most recent school transcript.
- H. Three letters of recommendation.
