Snowshoes Lending Policy

Approved by Board of Trustees: February 2024

In support of recreation and fitness, the Jacob Edwards Library and the Southbridge Health Department have provided snowshoes for the community to enjoy, and to expand library services.

- Valid library card and photo ID required for check out.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Only one pair of snowshoes may be borrowed per card.
- Snowshoes may only be used by the person who borrowed the pair or their child and signed the *Snowshoes Borrower Agreement*.
- The snowshoes may only be used during daylight hours.
- Must wear a helmet.
- Sign and date the Snowshoes Borrower Agreement.
- The library has four pairs of snowshoes of different sizes to lend three (19 inch) suitable for those under 125 lbs and one (23 inch) suitable for those under 225 lbs.
- The snowshoes are loaned for one week at a time.
- Southbridge residents may reserve snowshoes in advance.
- The library has the right to not lend snowshoes to a person if there are safety concerns.
