VIDEO GAME POLICY

As part of the library's mission to provide popular materials for the community, the library offers video games for circulation. The games are intended to be used on home equipment. At this time we will only be purchasing materials rated by the Entertainment Software Rating Board as EC (Early Childhood), E (Everyone) E10+ (Everyone 10 and older) and T (Teen).

- 1. The loan period is one week.
- 3. Games can be renewed only once.
- 4. Fines for overdue games will be \$1.00 per day.
- 5. Games must be returned with ALL parts, including disc or game card, case and all printed material.
- 6. Games must be returned in good condition. Discs must not be broken, scratched or cracked.
- 7. Full replacement costs will be charged for any game not returned with all components or in poor condition. A patron may alternately purchase a replacement game, which must be a brand new copy in its original packaging. Used games or donations will not be accepted as replacement.
