We are pleased to present this review of our activities in 2023. Thanks to the notable generosity of our members and donors and the unwavering dedication of a small team of hard-working volunteers, the Friends have been able to increase our support for the library with expanded fundraising activities. This support translates to substantial financial contributions which improve the library's ability to offer updated materials, discounted museum passes, and quality enrichment programming accessible to all area residents.

In February the Friends celebrated the library's Grand Reopening with a two-week membership drive, and in conjunction with the Summer Reading kick-off in June we organized a children's book sale. Steadfast volunteers on the Book Sales subcommittee also conduct monthly silent auctions and themed special sales, and recently revamped the Friends' Book Shop inside the library year-round. Surmounting many obstacles we finally launched online sales of curated book donations, propelled in large part by one determined member. Our Annual Trivia Night with the Friends fundraiser was more successful than ever, thanks to a very active subcommittee which implemented a basket raffle to complement the evening's festivities. On the administrative front, we revived our articles of incorporation and revised our bylaws. Other highlights include sponsorship of two children's programs and hosting a very well-received evening with renowned author Stephen Puleo.

Clearly the efforts of our devoted volunteers shine through all we do. We are ever grateful for those who contribute their time and talents, along with the "silent members" who give generously to support this worthwhile cause. As the recipient of less than 1% of Marshfield's annual budget, the town library depends on the Friends to enhance its ability to provide truly impressive and cost-free offerings to South Shore patrons. With your help we can continue to ensure that the Ventress Memorial Library remains a vibrant and vital community resource into 2024 and beyond.

FVML raises money for upgrades to book collections, purchases 12 passes to regional cultural attractions offering discounted or free admission to residents, and supports the library's efforts to promote literacy. Its volunteers sponsor educational and cultural programs to engage library patrons of all ages. FVML's vision and dedication enable our library to thrive as a vibrant asset to our community.


FUNDRAISING EFFORTS



Membership in the FVML increased by more than 44% in 2023. Our members provide the solid base of support and financial assistance to allow us to achieve our annual goal. In 2023 the annual membership drive was held in conjunction with the library's reopening after carpet replacement.

Our primary source of income is through the sale of gently used books and media. Funds were raised through ongoing sales at the Jean Christensen Friends' Book Shop, a book sale at the kickoff of summer reading, monthly special sale items, a monthly auction of high-quality books, and online sales of exceptional items. In 2023 the Book Store was updated to provide customers with contactless payment options through Venmo and PayPal. High visibility signage was added at the entrance of the Book Store.





The Friends held the third annual Trivia Night with Friends at Haddad's Ocean Café. In 2023, the event was enhanced by offering a Gift Basket raffle. Local businesses donated valuable items, baskets, and gift cards. The event was highly successful and enjoyed by all in attendance.
