LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

- FINANCIAL:
 - FY 23/24 Expenditures are at 64.97% of budget from tax appropriation. We're 68.77% through fiscal year.
- FEDERAL CAPITAL PROJECTS GRANT:
 - Grant was submitted on 3/12/2024. Proposed Capital Projects include purchase and installation of replacement windows, purchase and installation of automatic door opener, and purchase and installation of mini splits to replace non-functioning air conditioning.
 - o Total grant request is \$52,000.
- FIBERCONNECT:
 - New cables for internet will be installed possibly next week by Southern Vermont Tel. Was suppose to begin this week but he was called away for emergencies.
 - We will be staying with First Light as our internet until all our eRate money is used.
 - Then I will explore other options for an internet provider.

- Early Education Services (EES) STORY TIME:
 - I was approached by EES to host a Story Time. It is planned for April 23, from 1:30 to 2:30 PM. I will be helping them with publicity.
- Windham Solid Waste Management District Program:
 - I was approached by their Outreach Coordinator to do an educational program around recycling, trash or composting. The first phase is to have patrons answer survey questions to determine the program focus. The survey is here in the library.
