



The Unboxing:




Pull the tablet out and turn it on!

tablet**


**The other larger

Make sure to agree to the licensing terms and select “Adult or Teen” for who will be using the tablet





Google Account Setup


Enter your gmail email and

make one just for your tablet!


Then select what you want

off!









How to Add Apps


Let's Practice Together!


4. Once the app is installed, if you have a library card with us, you will have access to our ebook/audiobook selection right from your tablet!



Adding a Screen Lock

If you want your tablet password protected, here's some steps to get there!



1. Swipe up into the App Library and look for the Settings Icon

2. In settings, find the setting called “Unlock and Security”

3. Under “Unlock and Security”, there are several options. For a screen lock, look under the “Device Security” Section and you can choose what kind of lock you want!




Protecting Your Device:
