

Patron Policy

The Library will serve all residents of Wilton and the Pine Valley area of Milford. Persons residing outside the geographical area but owning property, working, or attending schools in the area shall be considered residents. All students attending Wilton-Lyndeborough Cooperative School District schools shall be considered residents.

Non-residents may use Library media at the discretion of the Library Director for the annual fee set by the Library Director and Board of Trustees.

Children may be assigned library cards with parental permission when they are five years old. Children age 12 or over may be assigned library cards without parental permission. Children must be present to accept their library card.

Use of the Library or its services may be denied by the Library Director for due cause. Such cause may be failure to return books or to pay penalties, destruction of Library property, disturbance of other patrons, or any group or organization, or any objectionable conduct on Library premises.

Patrons will follow rules of conduct set by the Library Director and Board of Trustees. See Appendix B*.

The public meeting room of the Library is available to non-profit educational, cultural, and other groups based in Wilton or substantially serving the town in accordance with Appendix A**.

Public access computers with an Internet connection are available to Library patrons. Rules for Internet use are set forth in Appendix E***.
