Facilities

- 1. The ramp closing affected library access. The state of New Hampshire has previously refused our request for a crosswalk from the parking lot to the front entrance. The trustees are concerned about the danger to patrons. We will have the same situation next year during the second stage of the ramp project.
- 2. The water service and sprinkler projects have difficulties. One question from the trustees is if taking the lawn route to the library as opposed to using Gregg Street would nullify the ability to use ARPA money for water service. Alison and Ron will work on a letter to the Select Board.
- 3. We will discuss contingency plans at the November meeting.

Meeting with Cambridge Trust

Lisa Tourangeau and Eric Jussaume presented their yearly review and explained their *Investment Presentation for Wilton Public Library.* Moved by Molly and seconded by Alison: that we use 3.5% as our investment percentage draw for the next year. The motion passed.
